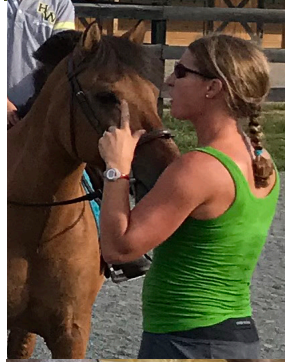
INSTRUCTORS
