One volunteer per team must be designated as horse management. One volunteer for scramble entries.
Refunds:	Follows VRPC policy, as indicated on VRPC website.
Attire:	White polo shirt, riding pants, Pony Club pin, completed USPC medical card in armband or medical bracelet, approved helmet and appropriate footwear. Belts excused. Senior and Advanced riders may wear breeches with tall socks and paddock boots. Club teams supply their own team white hat cover and set of pinnies 1-5. Scramble teams may borrow team pinnies on rally day, if necessary. White polo shirts are required for qualifying divisions.
Horse Management:	This is a one day trailer rally. Ponies may be stalled in trailers, or tied. Tents or trailers may be used for tack areas. For USPC games, there is no designated stable manager for each team. All team members share this responsibility. Each team does designate a Team Captain, who wears pinnie no. 1. Water for horses is available on site. Please clean up your manure and take it home. Appropriate barn footwear is required at all times.
Awards:	Medals or ribbons will be awarded to pony club teams in order of overall placing and Horse Management in each division. Costume contest prizes for games rally entrants mounted in costume. Approved helmet and appropriate footwear required for costume parade.
Arrival:	Enter at the Great Meadow polo arena horseman's gate. A traffic volunteer will direct trailers to designated parking areas by HM team. Team Captains may pick up packets upon arrival.
