### **Qualifying Competitors**

<u>USEF 2015 Training Level Tests</u> – T2 and T3 *and* competitors attempting to qualify for Championships must ride a training level musical, either individual kur or a pas de deux.

<u>USEF 2015 First Level Tests</u> – 1<sup>st</sup> 2 and 1<sup>st</sup> 3 *and* competitors attempting to qualify for Championships must ride a First Level musical, either individual kur or a pas de deux.

<u>USEF 2015 Second Level Tests</u>  $-2^{nd}$  2 and  $2^{nd}$  3 *and* competitors attempting to qualify for Championships must ride a Second Level musical, either individual kur or a pas de deux.

<u>USEF 2015 Third Level Tests</u>  $-3^{rd}$  2 and  $3^{rd}$  3 *and* competitors attempting to qualify for Championships must ride a Third Level musical, either individual kur or a pas de deux.

<u>USEF 2015 Fourth Level Tests</u> – 4<sup>th</sup> 2 and 4<sup>th</sup> 3 *and* competitors attempting to qualify for Championships must ride a Fourth Level musical, either individual kur or a pas de deux.

## Rings:

Introductory and Training Level tests are ridden in 20x40m arena. First Level & up tests, all individual musicals, pas de deux musicals, and quadrilles are ridden in 20x60m arena.

#### **Rides:**

- All Pony Club members MUST ride two tests. You will ride the lower test first and then the higher test. Scores from both tests will be included in final team placings.
- If wishing to qualify for USPC Championships, the competitor MUST ride a musical freestyle, pas de deux, or quadrille at their chosen level; ride ALL tests at one level at Training Level or above; and you may NOT ride USDF Introductory Tests.
- Pony Club members MAY also ride an individual musical freestyle and/or a pas de deux or quadrille.
- The qualifying criteria for Championships team selection are based on the competitor's two test scores, formal inspection score, turn-back score and all individual horse management penalties. Musical ride scores are not included in these criteria. NEW Qualifying Criteria for 2017: a competitor must earn a 60% or higher score on Test 3 of their competition level at the qualifying rally.
- Costumes are optional for all musical rides. However, riders must declare their intent to compete in costume. Leg wraps are allowed for those riding in costume with inspection at the Safety Check. Costumes are allowed for all Musical Rides at Championships.
- Leg wraps are also permitted for non-costumed pas de deux and quadrille freestyles with inspection at the Safety Check.
- Only D-1s and D-2s may have dressage tests read. Please indicate on entry form if this is required and provide name of reader. Leadline dressage for the USDF Intro tests will also be available.

#### Fees:

Entry fee \$82 per rider. Includes stall Saturday night if arriving Saturday and use of a stall on Sunday. Shavings are not provided; please bring your own. This will operate as a one-day rally but we will use stalls and not tie to trailers on Sunday. It is not necessary to have shavings in your stall during rally. You will need to keep the area tidy just as you would if your pony was tied to the trailer for the day. If shavings are used, you will need to strip the stall at the end of the rally. No fee for stable managers. Out-of-Region competitors' fee is \$107 per rider and on a space-available basis.

- Invoices and payment receipts are generated by the system and emailed to the member during the registration process.
- If choosing online payment: entries must be paid by April 27th.
- If choosing to pay by check, payment must be postmarked no later than April 24th.

## General:

- Competitors may arrive on Saturday, between 4:00 pm and 7:00 pm. Only stalls may be set up. Equipment may be unloaded, but no tack rooms may be set up on Friday.
- Stalls must be stripped before departure.
- Competitors are required to wear their completed USPC Medical Form in their medical armbands or USPC approved medical bracelet for the duration of the rally.
- Barn appropriate footwear is required at all times.
- Only the team captain or appointed designee may pick up registration packets.
- Chaperones must be available on-site for the duration of the rally.

#### Volunteers:

Minimum of three volunteers in addition to one chaperone per team entry is required. One volunteer per team must be designated as horse management.

Minimum of one volunteer for scramble entries is required.
