#### **Meeting Minutes**

- I. Call to Order Carrie Camp, RS
  - a. The meeting was called to order at  $5:40\ pm$
  - b. Attendance was taken. It was determined that a quorum was met.
- II. Approval of the November 2021 Minutes Cindy Shelberg, VRPC Secretary
  - a. Michelle A made a motion to accept the November 2021 Regional Council Minutes. Motion was seconded by Brook S. There were no changes or edits to the minutes.
  - b. VOTE: the motion passed unanimously.
- III. Financial Report Steve Vorphal, VRPC Treasurer (Attachment)
  - a. Steve reported on 2021 financial summary.

- 2021 Opening Balance on Jan 1 was \$45,495.48
   Balance on Dec 31 was \$48,125.85
   2021 net earnings were \$2,629.85.
- ii. Admin/Annual Mtg/Membership is the category where we base our budget from. Income was \$8,929, expenses \$6,529 with a net gain of \$2,401. Steve noted that we had budgeted \$1,300 for clubs to attend the USPC Virtual Annual Meeting, not many people took advantage of this opportunity.
- iii. Certifications income \$2,788, expenses \$3,755, with a loss of (\$877).
- iv. Champs income \$15,013, expenses were \$14,862 with a gain of \$151.
- v. Fundraising/Contributions income \$645, \$0 expenses, with a net gain of \$645. Due to sale of the Difficult Run equipment.
- vi. Instruction income \$817, expenses were \$2,000 with net loss of (\$1,200). We came out ahead because we budget \$1,500 for instruction program.
- vii. Rallies income \$27,823, expenses were \$26,275 with a net gain of \$1,549.
- viii. Rally Review Steve reviewed the profit/loss for each rally.
  - 1. D Rally profit \$1,725.84
  - 2. Dressage loss of (\$853.07)
  - 3. Eventing loss of (\$1,353.53)
  - 4. Games profit of \$1,123.98
  - 5. Horseless profit of \$423.78
  - 6. Show Jumping profit of \$476.76
  - 7. Tet profit of \$4.77
- ix. Historical Comparison of Rallies (Attachment)
  - 1. Since 2012 average rally profit is 1%. That equals to 8% per year.
  - 2. Since 2018, average rally profit is 23%; with a 35% profit overall.
  - 3. Participation since 2012 rally participation averages 46 per rally and 368 total participants.
  - 4. Carrie C noted that since 2018 the rally planning team has tried really hard to make rallies come out at a \$0 balance. In comparison, in 2016, rallies ran at a total loss of \$8,000. There was one loss leader, Dressage rally, which had 52 participants and a loss of \$3,900. We couldn't live with that. We have cut costs in the hotel rooms & choose carefully who we hire (we pay attention to what they will charge us). She asked for feedback on the stickers used at rallies and the first place prize for horse management. Last year the HM prize was a grooming bucket (costs was \$8.00 per bucket) This year the buckets will be blue and will have tack cleaning stuff. Michelle A noted that the buckets have been ordered and are being paid for by a grant (no budget impact).
- b. Carrie asked if there were any questions about the financials presented. No questions were asked.
- c. Carrie noted that when she took over for RS, I have always paid my way to annual meeting and champs. I have not asked the region to cover my expenses. Region had paid for the RS travel expenses in prior years. Carrie noted that there is no expense for administration travel since no other officers have submitted for expense to annual meeting. That is one reason we could have less loss in our budget. She also noted that the Region does pay for travel/accommodations for coaches that travel to champs.
- IV. RIC Introduction Lizzie Omstead

- a. Carrie noted that the budget for RIC is \$2,000.
- b. Lizzie introduced herself. She has coached at champs for past 2 years and at rallies for the past 12 years.
- c. She has reached out to multiple clubs about what the needs are for mounted and unmounted instruction. She thanked the members who replied to her survey.
- d. Michelle A noted that Lizzie's experience is vast and includes her USPC club membership at Seneca Valley and Old Dominion. Lizzie was a groom at the 2004 Olympics in Athens and a working student for Karen & David O'Connor and Phillip Dutton.
- e. Lizzie will begin with unmounted clinics first.
- f. Carrie noted that there is a need for an HB test and 10 potential candidates for upper-level testing. Carrie needs a few candidate names to reserve a date with USPC for upper level test.
- g. Carrie noted that Old Dominion is looking to hold an HB test in late spring early summer. She also noted that the HB test has changed drastically since we last put on an HB test. Now the test requires mounts available for jogs, bridle fitting. If Old Dominion Region puts on the test, they are looking at Bedford, VA near Lynchburg. Carrie would like to piggyback with Old Dominion. Michelle A recommended to work with Old Dominion on the HB test. Carrie noted that we have to fill the test which is 7 at 1 level or 10 with a mixed level (HB + HA). National will charge us for a minimum number of participants. Michelle A noted that were are 12 VRPC members interested in the HB test. Carrie will circle back with Old Dominion Region on the spring/summer HB test date. Mary S has 1 member, Maddie Mood interested in HB. Michelle A noted Old Dominion Hounds has 3 interested in HB test.
  - ACTION: Carrie C to confirm with Old Dominion about their HB test plans.
- h. Upper-Level test Carrie will reserve the C3, B with USPC August 12, 13, 14. She will add the A test if there are any VRPC members who will test for A. She will apply for the test as an eventing & dressage test. Mary S noted that Fair Hill will run an A test in mid August. Carrie noted that Mary S is chair of the upper-level committee at USPC.

ACTION: Carrie C to submit to USPC request for an upper level test in August.

- V. Rally Report 2021 Michelle Arnold, VRS Activities (Attachment)
  - a. Report presented in 2021 given in November meeting.
  - b. This year's Quiz Rally will have 86 members plus a few from Cresent Bay PC.
  - c. Mounted participants included 49 for D Rally. A larger turn out for Dressage Rally, Eventing 50, Show Jumping at 43, Tet at 42, Games 36.
  - d. Participation showed rally percentage by clubs. Michelle A noted it is really important to have a membership base that is active and participating. She noted it is also important to participate in rallies to put to test all of things kids have been learning and practicing, and to have a really good time in the barns. Carrie C let clubs know that if a club is not getting the participation they would like, the club DC should contact the region. She noted that the rallies are the place where the kids get to experience pony club. She feels involvement is key especially with the kids are in the 12-14 age group. Michelle A noted that when her child was interviewed about the rally, she said her favorite part of the rally was that the parents don't come back to the barns!
  - e. Michelle asked for feedback or comments. No comments were presented.
- VI. Rally Calendar 2022 Michelle Arnold, VRS Activities (Attachment)
  - a. She noted the 2022 rallies have some venue changes. She reviewed the dates for 2022 rallies.

- b. Dressage rally region needs volunteers to set up the rings and warm up ring. Carrie C is hoping to organize a volunteer team for each ring for setup. Rings need to be set up by 8 am the day of competition.
- c. D Rally will be June 18, and will piggyback with ODHPC summer camp.
- d. For every rally, every participant must have their own penny holder. None will be for sale at rallies.
- e. Divisions Carrie noted that last year we had parents competing with kids at rallies. She reported that parents are not in favor with mixing parent participants on teams with kids. Carrie contacted national office and USPC confirmed that regions can run rallies as we see fit. National also confirmed that mixing junior participants ages 17 & under with members 18 & old should include a signed parent waiver. Carrie proposed the following rally divisions:
  - Division A: Junior division under 18 or college age adults up to 21 & other members up to age 23 if a long-term member of their pony club and act as mentors to younger members. Will require parental signed waiver.
  - ii. Division B: Age 24 and older and any parent must compete in this division. No parent may be on a team with juniors, in general, especially if their child is a rider or stable manager.
  - iii. Prizes would be given to both Division A and Division B.
  - iv. Isabel M noted that it is unfair for one team to have a parent aged competitor, it is not in the pony club spirit.
  - v. Carrie noted that lots of high school seniors that are aged 18 want to be able to compete with their club members, with the other junior members. Division B can include mixing parents & adult children.
  - vi. Angie C noted that she doesn't mind the USPC recommended divisions of 17 & under division and the 18 & older division. She noted that she has been on a team with juniors as well as all seniors and has not gotten any negative feedback from other parents. Her goal is to get multiple horses from my barn competing. She noted that she has had great luck with the kids in the barns and feels like her being mixed with the junior teams she was a great mentor to the kids and all had a great time.
  - vii. Carrie noted that it would have been rude for parents to speak directly about their disapproval. With that said she has received feedback that is against mixing adults with junior competitors.
  - viii. Julie M mentioned she has a member who will turn 18 this year and rallied last year. This member is concerned that because she is now 18 she may be forced to go to adult division. She has said that she will not rally if she is moved to an adult division. She prefers to rally with her peers the 17 & under members.
  - ix. Michelle A noted that USPC has loosened the rules for divisions at local rallies, she thinks because of feedback from other regions. She did note that USPC may run Champs using the age groups of 17 & under in one division and 18+ in another division. And USPC may mix adults with junior team members depending on the type of entries at champs. She also noted that we don't have control as to how USPC runs the divisions on Champs.
- f. Ribbons Carrie Camp, Regional Supervisor
  - i. We have not given out ribbons for 7<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> place. For those places we have been giving stickers. I do like the idea of participation ribbons for 7-10 place. She asked for feedback about ribbons for the 7-10<sup>th</sup> place at rallies.

- Michelle A noted that at Horseless Rally everyone gets a medal. At Quiz everyone gets a ribbon. D Rally we did participation metals for places 7-10 plus they got stickers.
- iii. Carrie asked if we should do participation ribbon. It was noted that the participation ribbons really placate parents. Michelle A noted that the stickers have been received well. Michelle A suggested to keep the participation ribbons to Horseless, Quiz and D Rally. The group confirmed to keep this in place.
- g. Rally paperwork Michelle A noted that clubs must send in chaperone forms with entries. She requests all paperwork is submitted on time, with proper signatures.
- Late Fees Michelle A proposed that VRPC adds a late fee for entries received after the closing date. During discussion with members the fee of \$50 was suggested.
   Motion: Michelle A made a motion to add a \$50 late fee after closing date of individual entry. Motion was seconded by Lizzie Olmstead.
  - VOTE: the motion was passed.
- i. Dogs at Rallies Michelle A noted there have been issues with dogs at rallies and that we need to decide what rules we want to put in place about dogs. Michelle A suggested there are 2 options: no dogs or dogs that stay at the car in a pen/kennel. She noted that we will need to enforce no dogs at barns or in warm up area. Carrie C noted that dogs on leashes have lashed out at other dogs/people. Carrie noted that keeping a dog in a kennel at a car that would be ok. Discussion: Brook S agreed with no dogs rule. Elizabeth C noted that then we would have to enforce the rule. Angie C noted that most horse people also have dogs and most bring to other competitions. It will be a tough rule to enforce. Mary S agreed with no dog rule. She suggested that if the rule is noted in the rally invite, and we will get less dogs. Then we can talk with those that ignore the no dog rule. She noted that she has had some bad experiences at competitions with dogs herself. Michelle A said she will put it in invitation and asked DC's to communicate to coaches about our new no dogs rule.

#### VII. Membership Update – Michelle Arnold, VRS Activities

- i. Michelle A noted that DC's need to review the status of their members. She noted that we have members that are members of USPC but not VRPC, and some that are members of VRPC but not USPC she blocks them in the system. She reminded DC's that members should not participate in club activities unless they are a member of USPC. If your member is 18 and hasn't completed Safe Sport, they have been suspended. If your member is 21+ and hasn't completed Safe Sport and a background check they should not participate in any club activities. These are USPC rules. Michelle A has sent a spreadsheet to all DC's on the status of members that need attention on membership requirements. Michelle A noted that the reason for membership in USPC is for insurance coverage. Brook S noted that membership issues should be resolved before rally entries. Michelle A noted that region will not approve VRPC membership if member has not completed USPC membership.
- ii. Leader training Michelle A reminded leaders to complete USPC training. Carrie noted that USPC requires her to reapprove a leader that has a lapsed USPC membership because they fall out of compliance with training components. She is inclined to not approve a club leader that has ignored the reminders and let their membership lapse. Carrie C noted that all trainers & instructors need Safe Sport & background checks. Carrie C noted that Assist Horse Management judges are not required to complete Safe Sport or a background check.

iii. Certification updates in VRPC website – Michelle A asked that DC's fill out certification form after every certification. The form is under VRPC website under Certificates/Administration. Angie C asked how to change to the national certifications. National certification changes should be sent to Macy Matot at USPC.

#### VIII. USPC Champs 2022 – Carrie Camp, RS

- a. 2022 Champs will be in Tryon, NC July 27-31
- b. Carrie C assumes move in dates or July 27 & 28.
- c. Tryon has almost no hotels, most are 45 minutes or more away from the facility. Tryon cabins are great. She recommends getting a golf cart.
- d. Shirts Carrie C asked if we should stay with the same style or color. Members agreed to keep same color/pattern/style.
- e. Coaches Carried asked the group if they prefer the region to hire coaches for champs. She asked members to submit names if there is someone they would like to considered. We have hired 2 coaches so far. Lizzie O has agreed to be a coach. Bennett Camp-Crowder, Carrie's daughter, has agreed to coach. Michelle A noted that we may hire a third coach that is not a professional to keep costs down. Carrie C noted that we will not change the amount we pay coaches. Angie C asked if we are hiring a third coach. Carrie C said that if there is somebody qualified and send in the name. Angie C noted the coaching schedule seemed tight because we had so many kids to attend to. Michelle A noted a third coach would increase champs fee to participants.

#### IX. New Business –

- a. Virginal Horse Board Grant VHIB \$5,000grant received by VRPC. Grant is split between venue rental & ribbons. The ribbons and medals will include the VHIB name.
- b. Regional Zoom Meetings Michelle A presented the concept for a series of zoom meetings where the clubs share topics/activities in discussions with each other. Designed to generate conversation among clubs & learn from each other. Zoom meetings would be held a few times a year. Discussion: Stefanie C, Julie M, Elizabeth C, Mary S, Angie C agreed that it is a good idea.
  - ACTION: Regional staff will put together a calendar of Zoom club to club meetings.
- c. Angie C asked if clubs can put fund raising can go on VRPC calendar. Carrie C confirmed yes and asked that all info be sent to Cindy Shelberg.
- d. Club Annual Meetings Carrie C mentioned that club annual meetings should be held no later than Oct 30 so clubs can file paperwork before USPC deadline Nov 15.
- e. Peer Review Steve mentioned Peer Review deadline in February. Carrie C asked that all clubs that have missed the peer review deadline send her a note to notify of that the club will be completing the peer review later in the year.
- f. Next meeting will be Nov 9, 2022 at 5:30 pm at PATH Foundation.
