Divisions: This will be a qualifying Games Rally for 2023 USPC Championships.

Games Rally is a fun first rally for new members. Non-members and adults welcome. The following divisions will be offered if participation allows (no leadline division offered):

First Timers - non-qualifying; 2 to 5 riders with one C advisor, 6-17 years of age as of 1/1/22

(not a leadline division)

Junior—4 or 5 riders, 10-17 years of age as of 1/1/22 Senior—4 or 5 riders, 18-adult years of age as of 1/1/22

Advanced Pairs—2 riders, C-1 FL, 18-adult years of age as of 1/1/22

The following divisions (and rating criteria) are offered at USPC Championships. If you plan to qualify for Champs in 2023, please be certain you are competing at the proper HM level that you are attempting to qualify in, discuss with your DC if you are considering attending Champs 2023:

Standard Championship Division:

Junior Team 12-17 years of age, minimum C-1 DR/EV/Flat/HSE Advanced Pairs 18 years of age and up, minimum C-1 DR/EV/Flat/ HSE.

Modified Championships Divisions

Junior Team 10-17 years of age, minimum D-2 DR/EV/Flat/HSE Senior Pairs 18 years of age and up, minimum D-2 DR/EV/Flat/ HSE.

Entry Fee: Entry fee is \$62 per rider for Pony Club members. Add \$25 for non-Pony Club.

Payment: Check with your club or center regarding payment policies—do they pay for your entry? If yes,

then do not pay online or send check. Let the Club or Center handle payment.

If you are paying for yourself, we GREATLY prefer that you pay online if at all possible.

Volunteers: Three volunteers in addition to one chaperone per team entry are required. One volunteer per team

must be designated as horse management. One volunteer for scramble entries.

Attire: Polo shirt, riding pants, approved helmet and appropriate footwear. Club teams supply their own

team white hat cover and team pinneys. Scramble teams will be loaned team pinneys and a white

hat cover at rally check in.

Horse Management:

This is a one-day trailer rally. Ponies may be stalled in trailers or tied. Tents or trailers may

be used for tack areas. For USPC games, there is no stable manager. All team members share this responsibility. Each team does designate a Team Captain, who wears piney number 1. Water for horses is available on site. Please clean up your manure and take it home. Appropriate barn

footwear is required at all times.

Awards: Ribbons will be awarded to pony club teams in order of overall placing and Horse Management

Arrival: Enter at the Great Meadow polo arena horseman's gate. A traffic volunteer will direct trailers to

designated parking areas by HM team. Team Captains may pick up packets upon arrival.
